

# Free Tour of the Shimabara Peninsula



**The Prefecture of Nagasaki is recruiting participants for a tour of the Shimabara Peninsula targeting residents of Nagasaki Prefecture from Western countries.**

- ※ Upon the registration of “Hidden Christian Sites in the Nagasaki Region” as a World Heritage Site, the purpose of this event is to create a personal network for the development of policies related to the West. For this reason, participants are limited to people from Western countries.

## Summary

- **Date** : Sat Nov 17<sup>th</sup> to Sun Nov 18<sup>th</sup> 2018 (2 days, 1 night)
- **No. of Participants**: About 15 people
  - ※ Please fill in the necessary details on the application form and submit it by e-mail, post, fax, or in person to the Nagasaki Prefecture International Affairs Division.
  - ※ If more than 15 applications are received, participants will be drawn at random from the applications received.
- **Costs**: **Free** (Participants will be responsible for travel costs to and from their residence to the Nagasaki Prefectural Office.)
- **Requirements for Participants** :
  - ① Participants must be residents of Nagasaki Prefecture from a Western country who are at least 20 years of age.
  - ② Participants must register on the “Dejima Network” website (<http://dejima-network.pref.nagasaki.jp/en/>) run by the Nagasaki Prefecture International Affairs Division.
  - ③ Participants are asked for their co-operation in completing surveys in order to improve the appeal of Nagasaki Prefecture’s tourist destinations and how they receive guests.
  - ④ Participants must behave in an orderly fashion and agree to follow the plan for this tour.
  - ※ During the tour, explanations will be given in English and Japanese.
  - ※ During and after the tour, participants are encouraged to use social media to share points of interest in Nagasaki Prefecture.
  - ※ As a general rule, accommodation will be two people per room (shared rooms).
- **Application deadline** : Applications must arrive by 5pm, Wed Oct 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018

- 【11/18 (Sun)】 Sightseeing in the Shimabara Peninsula→ Nagasaki City (About 5 pm)  
〔Hara Castle Ruins, Shimabara – Streets with Swimming Carp, Group Discussion, etc〕
- ※ Locations visited may change depending on weather conditions on the day.
  - ※ At the end of the trip, the bus will make a few stops along the way to Nagasaki City to allow you to make your way home.
